FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION: Next Sunday, June 6, is the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). In the year 1264, this feast, commemorating the institution of the Holy Eucharist, became the first papally sanctioned feast in the history of the Catholic Church and the Eucharistic procession became a principal feature of the feast's celebration shortly thereafter. We will begin this sacred feast with Mass on Saturday, June 5, at 8:00 a.m. Mass will be followed by 24-hour adoration, ending with a Eucharistic Procession at 8:00 Sunday morning. If you come to 8:15 Mass next Sunday, please come early and join in the procession, or if the procession is in progress as you arrive, please quietly join us.
